Urban Area Boundaries - MPO Boundary Impacts

□ December 29, 2022:

- US Census Bureau announced list of qualifying urban areas from the 2020 Census
- Due to its population being greater than 50,000, Eagle Pass will become an MPO
- Seven (7) existing MPOs will/may have to slightly expand their boundaries to contain area recently designated as urban, the most significant of which is that Alamo MPO will need to expand into Medina County.
- TPP staff will soon begin working to adjust the raw census urban boundaries with the goal of having these changes reflected in our Year of End 2023 data

□ Late March/early April:

Meeting in Eagle Pass (TxDOT, FHWA, FTA, and potentially AMPO)

□ Fall 2023:

Initiate 2025 UTP Development based on new urbanized areas



□ Fall/Winter 2023:

- MPOs adjust to align with census
- TxDOT coordinate with Governor's Office on designation of Eagle Pass MPO

□ Summer/Fall 2024:

New TMAs have Congestion Management Plans

□ August 2024:

 2025 UTP Adoption providing distribution that aligns with new boundaries and associate data

□ Fall 2026:

New MPOs should adopt MTP and TIP








- MPO Boundaries Affected by Urban Area Boundaries

 - Tyler (Bullard no longer in)






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


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


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


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


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


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


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
