Upcoming Initiatives



- STIP and UTP timeline synchronization (effort ongoing)
- Biannual STIP Workshop (first one tentative June 2023)
 - Communicate importance of consistency across documents
 - Understand common challenges and exceptions
 - Reduce project changes in last few months before letting
- District project readiness reviews with every new STIP (current effort led by Design Division)
- STIP Guidance Manual supported by FHWA, Districts, MPOs, Divisions, and FTA (2024)
- Recorded training and recurring live training for Districts, Divisions, and MPOs (2024)
- eSTIP business rules and email notifications to STIP team, District, and MPO
 - Cost increase
 - 50% rule on federal cost
 - Scope change
 - Project limits change
