Active Transportation Planning Accomplishments




Laying the groundwork for the State's first-ever Active Transportation Plan

TxDOT District Bicycle Plans Overview


- Provide a basis for future district planning and project development

 - Refine Bicycle Tourism Trail routes






Pedestrian Safety Action Plan


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
